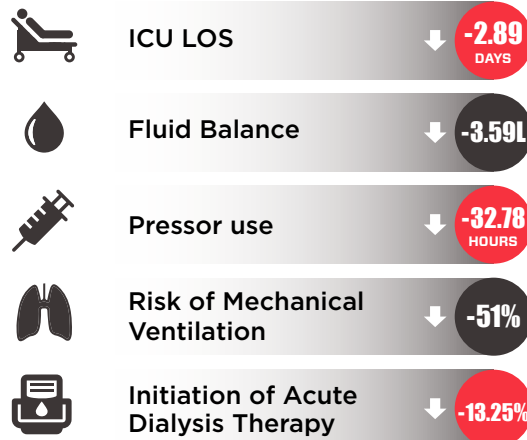
NEW YEAR'S FLUID RESOLUTIONS

It's a new year which means it's a perfect time to make some New Year's FLUID Resolutions!

Here are some great reasons to prioritize better fluid management in 2018:

- IV FLUIDS ARE DRUGS: they have a therapeutic range and should be dosed according to patient response, just like any other drug.
- There is a better way to manage fluids using Stroke Volume Index as a guide because it provides objective data about whether that fluid is helping or potentially harming our patient.
- We know that using a Stroke Volume guided approach, specifically in sepsis, improves patient outcomes. See the recent data from the University of Kansas Medical Center.

A recent University of Kansas Medical Center study in Severe Sepsis and Septic Shock Patients shows that **optimized fluid management** can lead to improved patient outcomes!
